If you have not already heard, on Sunday, January 21st, our precious 12 year old daughter, Diana García was welcomed into the presence of her Lord and Savior Jesus Christ at 6:30 pm. She died of complications from the flu. She has been a member of our family since she was a little girl.

Díana was beautiful, smart, funny, spunky, full of love for others, and she will be missed forever by all who knew her. Her favorite color was blue. She loved her H2H family without reservation and dreamed of becoming a missionary when she grew up. On Monday, January 22nd, she was laid to rest surrounded by over 200 members of her family, church, friends, teachers, and classmates; snuggled lovingly in her favorite blanket. Her journal was full of scripture she had copied, of drawings, and an especially poignant letter she had written to Mommie Amy and Tio Oscar; full of thanks and love for them. Last August, Díana, who had asked Jesus into her heart, was one of the 18 H2H Family kids who were baptized one bright Sunday morning down at the ríver.

Her Mommie, Tio, Gramma, her sisters and brothers, the Village Mommies, church family,

classmates and teachers, and all of you who knew her and loved her, can be comforted by the fact that we will all be together with Jesus someday. Díana's 5th grade classmates and teacher made a bulletin board memorial for her, covered with heart messages. We honored her life at our allschool chapel on Wednesday. And at the Village, the girls' living room is literally papered, all 4 walls, with pictures and messages of love for their beloved sister.

The Gaither song, "The Family of God" says, "I'm so glad I'm a part of the Family of God. I've been washed in the fountain, cleansed by His Blood, joint heirs with Jesus, as we travel this sod, For I'm part of the family, the Family of God."

This has been such a hard week for all of us, but I so love how

our Father takes care of us through this Family of God. Dave Batchelor, a retired elementary school counselor from Centralia, WA, is here right now, volunteering for 2 months, and knew just what to do to help our kids through this time of grieving.

Lisa Closner, Tia Lisa to all our girls over the last 9 years, came down with Rick Stephens to love and comfort all of us. Steven Ware and his Trinity Lutheran Church held a special memorial service for her in New York. And lastly, thank you to all of you who sent loving prayers and words of comfort to help us through.

With the departure of our Diana, none of us will ever be the same. But God will use this heartbreak for our good and His glory, just as He has throughout all the years of our journey in His ministry, Worldwide Heart to Heart.




