Our Heroes, Our Kids

When this ministry began, we had a vision of not only rescuing and raising these children, but of giving them a hope in Jesus and a future. Right now, almost half of our children are between the ages of 15 and 27. Of those, 30 are in College and the rest are in High School.

I remember Amy kiddingly telling Sarah and Rachel when they were little and complaining about doing chores, "That's what I borned ya for!!" Our children all have chores and most have jobs that not only help our family run smoothly but help with ministering to the needs of others as missionaries in their own communities. They all have had the opportunity to be part of our Body and Soul Food Ministry this past year, preparing and delivering food to hundreds of people.

Adonis is head of maintenance for both schools, the clinic, and the church. Jehovany helps him and is a full-time guard for us. Both also go to college.

Nelson is head of maintenance at the Village and goes to college online.

Mayra, Iveth, Katherine, and Nicholas are helping in the classrooms at the village and going to college online.

Nora and Alba work at the Baby House for us.

Felipe manages the farm for us, and Nahun, Guillermo, Corbin, and Julio assist him.

The gifts God gave them are being developed, and the skills they have learned and are learning in our family are invaluable tools that will help them be successful for the rest of their lives.

School

We will soon be finished with this school year. I have been going to the village each week to do Brain Game challenges with the kids. Our "Slowest Marble" designs and "The Great International Egg Drop Contests, Parts I and II", have given our kids a chance to use their creativity while having a great time! Last Friday was "Sunglasses Day" to end our Spirit Week in April. Our five Seniors, Deysi, Ana, Norma, Cesar and Darwin, will graduate in June and join the ranks of our current kids in college next fall. Our "baby", Dunia also graduates from Prepa.







Marcel and Elvia's House

Marcel and Elvia have worked alongside us in H2H here in Honduras for over 20 years. Their home was destroyed by the two hurricanes last November. Oscar and our boys went to work rebuilding it, and our girls did the finish work, painting the whole thing.

Food delivery

We are continuing to deliver food to families still struggling from their losses in the Hurricanes last November. We headed to Baracoa this week. We were told there were protests and the road was closed. We prayed. About five minutes after reaching the barricade, it parted and we were allowed through before it closed again. Amazing Grace!!





The Farm

Our mountain farm is doing great. We are close to harvesting our second crop. Our boys are putting the finishing touches on the 3 bed/3 bath house they just built there. Recently, Oscar and four of our girls installed solar power in the house, wired it, and lit it with bulbs they made. Our first well on the property is dug and functioning.
