

The cost to attend our school which includes tuition, books, uniforms, and insurance will be \$1800 for the 2019-20 school year (\$150 per month). 76 of the 215 children now enrolled are our H2H family, and we partial scholarship all our staffs' children and the children of local pastors and missionaries. SO...I am hoping to find an education sponsor for each of our 76 kids for next year.
- Funds to put AC in the new second floor classrooms and to outfit our new second floor Science Lab.
