Greetings and Happy Easter from Worldwide Heart to Heart Ministries. It is such a joy to write to you all once again and tell you that God is good, God is faithful and God is Love.

This month has been Father's day in Honduras which is March 19th. It has really made me focus on how much grace is in the love of the Father, and that not even a sparrow falls from the sky goes unnoticed. We continue to face wave after wave of continued attacks, and we really don't know why, but we know that God is with us all the time. Yesterday to be exact, we had 10 of our Heart to Heart children at the clinic with fevers, stomach issues, coughs, etc. I myself have been ill for going on for two weeks now, and Mary and her husband Lyle have been ill, as well. Many of our teachers have been out sick, as well as children from the village and town. The good news is that spring break begins this Friday. It will be such a restful time for us and our kids! But even in the difficulties, God always seems to send something our way saying, "See I knew this, and I provided." We currently have a team from New York who were able to help sub for the absent teachers. God is good!

We have been blessed by a few teams lately. Gary and Sylvia Thacker were here with members of their home church in Mineola, Texas. The team assisted the school, but also did many wonderful things for the village, such as providing a new fridge for the boy's house. They also went out with the church on several evangelical and food distribution programs. Since the major floods that hit this country back in October of last year and then again in January of this year, a very generous donor has provided food for over 100 families that lost their homes and farms with provisions of food. The team went with our church to provide for the

families, as well as provided food for an additional 45 more families in need. We are so thankful to this team and we pray that God blesses them in every way. We hope to see them all in Honduras again soon!

Currently, we have a team serving from New York State. Elvia Toombs has been a friend of the ministry, since she came with her friend Patricia North back in 2016. Elvia is a Dental Hygienist and has spent time doing cleanings for our kids' teeth this week. The rest of her team have been assisting at the school and have been a tremendous help in our time of need. They have many fun activities planned with the kids for this week such as dying Easter eggs and some crafts. They also came down with a whole suitcase of jelly beans and plastic eggs for hiding! We are so blessed by this team and so thankful they are here. We pray this is your first trip of many!

We also want to say a special thanks to two very special people. Dave Batchelor, was a man sent by God and we are so thankful. Dave volunteered with H2H from January to the beginning of March, and during his time with us, our beautiful Diana went to be with the Lord. As many of you know, we lost Amabilia back in July, so the children had already suffered the loss of "family", but never so closely the loss of one of their own. Still today, 2 months later, her loss is so shocking! Once again God said, "I've got this!" Dave has over 20 years' experience as a grief counselor, and at that very time, he knew exactly what to do. He brought colors, markers and paper, and he let the kids color their feelings. The result was a room that was completely wall-papered with heartfelt prayers, poems, songs and some simple drawings of tears. He was able to work with the kids through their grief. He also saw many simple needs around the

village, such as replacement of the windows and took out of his own pockets to provide. We are very thankful, Dave, for your love and friendship!

We were also blessed by a short visit by our long-time friend Gerald Palmer. He and his family have sponsored many of our children for several years. He blessed H2H in his short time here with a new fridge and washer for our university girls in San Pedro Sula, as well as a Pizza Party for the entire village. Many thanks for your visit!

Overall, we have been so blessed this month knowing that God knew it all before hand and has cared for us in so many ways. As always, we are so thankful from the bottom of our hearts for your love and support.

Mary's News ... WELCOME SPRING


